

3.2 Count Nouns & Noncount Nouns

With **count nouns**, you can use the word **"many"**:

a car → many cars
 a house → many houses
 a boy → many boys
 a computer → many computers

a shirt → many shirts
 a cup → many cups
 a hand → many hands
 a pen → many pens



With **noncount nouns**, you can use the word **"much"**:

water → much water
 sand → much sand
 money → much money
 time → much time

homework → much homework
 soup → much soup
 snow → much snow
 hair → much hair
