You can use "a lot of" with both count and noncount nouns!

Count Nouns

dog → many dogs
book → a lot of books
window → many windows

friend → a lot of friends
knife → many knives
child → a lot of children

Noncount Nouns

milk → a lot of milk
cake → much cake
juice → a lot of juice

rice → much rice
love → a lot of love
money → much money
