

4.4 Future Tense: Review



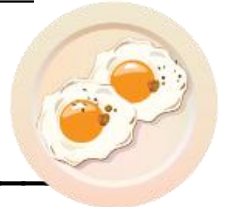
We use the **future tense** to talk about things that will happen **after now**.
