

4.1 Subject - Verb - Object

The **subject** of a sentence is what the sentence is about.
The verb in a sentence is the action word.
The **object** receives the action of the verb.



The cat ate **the mouse**.

→ The cat ate what? The mouse! **“The mouse”** is the object.

John helped **his sister**.

→ John helped whom? His sister! **“His sister”** is the object.

We found **a watch** when we were jogging.

→ What did you find? A watch! **“A watch”** is the object.
