

### 3.1 Introduction to Past Tense

We use the **past tense** to talk about things that happened **before now**.



For past tense, you often add **-ed** to the verb (these are called the **Regular Verbs**):

May **played** basketball last night.

We **watched** a movie in class this morning.

My little brother **started** school last week.

I **finished** my homework 10 minutes ago.
