We use the **past tense** to talk about things that happened **before now**.

You can use these words to talk about time in the past tense:



yesterday	last night	a few minutes ago
the day before yesterday	last week	an hour ago
this morning	last month	two days ago
at 10:00am	last year	three weeks ago
Monday night	last weekend	one year ago
