

## 4.3 Verbs

Verbs are **action words**. Verbs are things that you can do!

- Can you **think**? Yes! "**Think**" is a verb!
- Can you **drink**? Yes! "**Drink**" is a verb!
- Can you **work**? Yes! "**Work**" is a verb!

With **He**, **She**, and **It**, you have to **add -s (or -es)** to the verb:

| <b>She</b> | <b>drinks</b> | <b>sees</b>  | water.            |
| <b>It</b>  | <b>works</b>  | <b>hears</b> | every weekend.    |
