Am, Is, and **Are** are verbs, too.

Am, Is, and **Are** are called "Be Verbs," because they mean "to be."

- Wrong: I be a girl. (x)
- Right: I **am** a girl.

- Wrong: He be a boy. (x)
- Right: He **is** a boy.

- Wrong: They be students. (x)
- Right: They **are** students.
