Sentence Pattern

(not) ... at all

- “**at all**” means “not even a little”, and you usually put it at the end of a **negative sentence** (a sentence with “not”).

Examples:

Brian: Are you hungry?

Dave: I just ate dinner. I’m not hungry **at all**.

Amanda: Do you know anything about Chinese history?

Sandra: No, I don’t know anything **at all** about Chinese history?My friend said there was a big storm last night, but I didn’t hear anything **at all**.**Rewrite these sentences using “at all”**
