On the second floor there are two bathrooms. One is for the children to use and one is in the master bedroom for Patrick and his wife. Their house also has a basement and a garage. They put things they don't use in the basement. They park their car in the garage. Patrick's house also has a front yard and a back yard for the children to play in.

Kathy lives alone in an apartment. Her apartment is in an apartment building. The building has twelve floors. Kathy lives on the tenth floor. Her apartment has two bedrooms. One is for her and the other is a guest room. Her apartment also has a kitchen, a bathroom and a living room. The living room has a balcony with a good view. In the basement of the building there is a parking garage. All the people who live in the building can park their cars there. There is a garden on the roof of the building. The garden has many kinds of flowers and plants for the residents to enjoy.
