

10.4 Irregular Adverbs

Not all adverbs end in “-ly.”

Here are some **irregular adverbs** that don't end in -ly.

- far** (I can run very far.)
- fast** (I can run very fast.)
- hard** (John hit me very hard.)
- high** (The plane is flying very high.)
- late** (I finished late.)
- long** (I slept very long last night.)
- low** (The plane is flying very low.)
- well** (She can sing very well.)

*Don't forget: **good** is an adjective; **well** is an adverb.
