

## 7.1 Comparative Adjectives (with -er)

You can also add **-er** to many adjectives. "**-er**" means "more."





\*If you add -er to an adjective that ends in y, you have to change the y to i, and then write -er. (Fill in the blanks below.)

\*If an adjective ends in "short vowel + consonant," you have to double the consonant, then add -er. (Fill in the blanks below.)
