### VOCAB LIST: People in the Government

**president** – the leader of a country (usually elected, like in the USA)

**vice president** – the second most powerful person (after the president)

**prime minister** – the leader of a country (usually appointed, like in the UK)

**monarch** – a king or queen

**dictator** – a person who controls a country by force

**legislator** – one of the people who makes the laws in a country (usually in a “legislature”)

**Senator (US)** – legislators in the US Senate

**Minister of Parliament (UK)** – legislators in the UK Parliament

**governor** – the leader of a state

**mayor** – the leader of a city

**representative** – any person who represents other people (presidents, governors, and mayors are all examples of representatives)

**Secretary (US) / Minister (UK)** – a person appointed by the president/prime minister to lead a department in the government

**citizen** – a “member” of a country; a person born in a particular country who has certain rights

**voter** – a person (citizen) who votes for the representatives (in a democracy)
